- Upcoming symposia sponsored, co-sponsored, or officially endorsed by SNAME and its sections - **non-SNAME symposia information will not be included**

- A short summary of **under 50 words** should be provided via email to meichler@sname.org. Please title the email "for TNT"
- A link is necessary – provide a link to the paper, meeting, or website relevant to the content/production channel in the email.
- Members who wish to circulate papers directly should verify in the email that they wish to have SNAME members contact them directly to receive copies.
