SNAME Awards \$165,000 in Scholarships

Graduate and Undergraduate Scholarship Winners Announced

Eleven Graduate Scholarships were awarded. Most notable among these are Ryan Pfeifer of Webb Institute, winner of the Mandell and Lester Rosenblatt Undergraduate Scholarship, and Christopher D. The Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers has awarded millions of dollars in scholarships to graduate and undergraduate students since 1933. The 2010-11 awards bring the total number of Graduate Scholarship awards to 426 and undergraduate awards to 1,062 over the history of the Society.

Maclean, P.E. has continued to give the selection process the dedicated care that has characterized the various Scholarships Committees work through the years.
